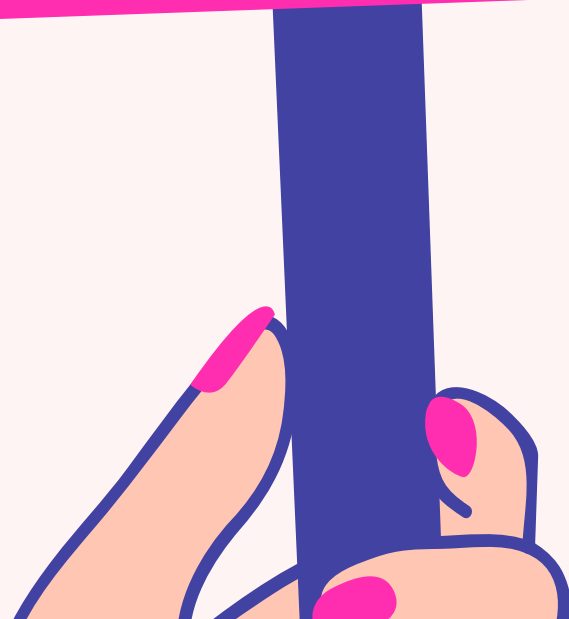

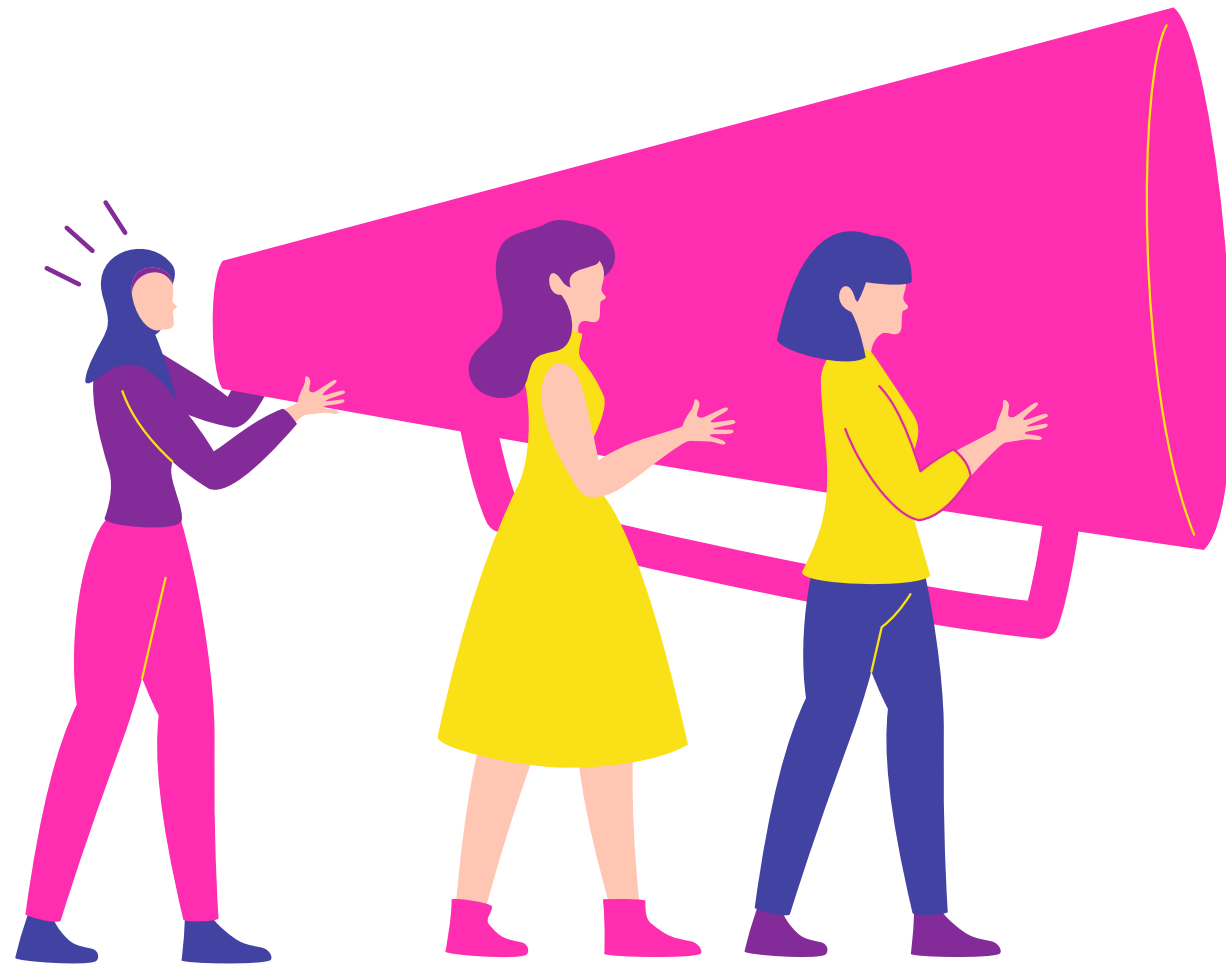


What is violence against women?



"Any act of gender-based violence that results in, or is likely to result in, physical, sexual, or mental harm or suffering to women, including threats of such acts, coercion or arbitrary deprivation of liberty, whether occurring in public or in private life".

Violence against women globally



- According to World Health Organization, 1 in 3 (30%) of women worldwide have been subjected to either physical and/or sexual violence in their lifetime.
- Less than 40 per cent of the women who experience violence seek help of any sort.
- Among women who do seek help, most look to family and friends.
- Fewer than 10 per cent of those seeking help reported to the police.



LATIN AMERICA

Colombia

149 cases of violence against women in the National University of Colombia were registered between December 2017 and March 2019.

Types of violence

- 46 cases of sexual harassment
- 16 of sexual offense
- 33 cases of non-consensual sexual act



LATIN AMERICA

Brazil

Out of 1823 interviewed:

- 67% suffered some form of sexual violence
- 63% did not report it to authorities

Types of violence

- 56% affirmed having been victims of sexual harassment
- 28% victims of sexual violence

SOUTH AFRICA

30% of female learners were raped and sexually harassed by male learners and teachers in schools

Sexual Harassment

25.5% of the females had experienced unwanted touching

Rape

2.7% female students admitted that they have been raped

Sexual relationships

10.2% of the females had been coerced to comply with a sexual relationship on campus.



MALAWI

Sexual Harassment

67% of the females had experienced sexual harassment

Rape

12.6% female students admitted that they have been raped

FRANCE – Strasbourg

53% of the respondents revealed that they have experienced some kind of psychological or emotional violence in HEI - University of Strasbourg

Verbal Harassment

46% females reported having heard people in their institutions insulting, ridiculing, or mocking women in general

Safety

37% women reported not feeling safe around their male classmates/colleagues
51% women agreed that the physical violence was preceded by psychological violence



Spain

Violence

49% of the respondents indicated that they have experienced or that they know persons who have suffered more than one type of violence against women in the university

The majority of the cases (84%) the victim was a female student

25% of the persons who had known about or witnessed violence against women stated that the aggressor was a professor

Australia

Sexual Harassment

one in six (16.1%) students had been sexually harassed since starting at university and one in twelve (8.1%) had been sexually harassed in the past 12 months.

Safety

Female students (10.5%), transgender students (14.7%) and non-binary students (22.4%) were more likely to have had these experiences in a university context in the past 12 months when compared with male students (3.9%).

Bangladesh

Sexual Harassment

in eight universities, 76% of female students had faced incidents of sexual harassment

United States of America

Stalking

5.8% of students have experienced stalking since entering college

Sexual Assault and rape

13% of all students experience rape or sexual assault through physical force, violence, or incapacitation (among all graduate and undergraduate students)

Among graduate and professional students, 9.7% of females experience rape or sexual assault through physical force, violence, or incapacitation

Among undergraduate students, 26.4% of females experience rape or sexual assault through physical force, violence, or incapacitation
